Lead in Drinking Water in Schools and Daycare SB247 Prevention of Childhood Lead Poisoning

To Staff, Parents/Guardians, and Students:

This notice serves to fulfill notification requirements in accordance with SB247. SB247 requires all schools to test lead in drinking water at all locations where water is available for consumption by children. The testing had to be completed by July 1, 2019. We completed our testing on April 8, 2019 and received the results on April 16, 2019.

The lab results showed that we are in compliance. While the ultimate goal is for zero lead exposure, the action level in drinking water is currently set at 15 parts per billion (ppb) or 0.015 milligrams per liter (mg/L) as the threshold to implement remedial actions.

The lab results are available for review during school hours, Monday through Friday.
